



1. Remove the luminaire (Fig 1) and accessories (Fig 2) from the carton and inspect luminaire for damage. Do not install a damaged luminaire.







2. Prepare site. Get the anchor bolt carrier assembled as (Fig 3) and use it to determine placement of anchor bolts in concrete. Ensure that concrete base is suitable for the bollard load.





3. Install three anchor bolts into concrete as per attached drawing, having at least 1-1/2~2" protruding from concrete with threads free and clear of debris and dirt.












4. Using the hex wrench, loosen the screws on the side of the head, and open the top head.







5. Set slip switch to the position of your wattage, CCT and photosensor selection according to the label on fixture. (Remove the plug screws required for BLA-R-24AS) (Default setting is 24W, 5000K, Photosensor OFF)






6. Put the top head back on and tighten the screws.









7. Using the hex wrench, loosen the screws on the side of the bottom, and separate the fixture body from the mounting base.







8. Place bollard mounting base over anchor bolts, and tighten M10 washer, spring washer and nuts.





9. Put the fixture body back on and tighten the screws. Install the 180° Shield Kit for round fixture

Wiring

- 1. Connect the black fixture lead to the (+) LINE supply lead.
- 2. Connect the white fixture lead to the (-) COMMON supply lead.
- 3. Connect the GROUND wire from fixture to supply ground. Do NOT connect the GROUND of the dimming fixture to the output.
- 4. Connect the purple fixture lead to the (V+) DIM lead.
- 5. Connect the gray fixture lead to the (V-) DIM lead.
